Student Drop off and Pick Up Plan





The Kennedy Elementary Safety Committee has created a safety plan so all students arrive at school and are picked up from school in a SAFE way.

The plan will reduce congestion in front of the school (on Meadowlark) at both arrival and dismissal times and will keep our crosswalks visible for the safety of our children.

If you drive or walk your child to or from school, please read the guide and look at the map to determine a plan for getting your child to school safely.



If you walk to school...

Always use the crosswalks and crossing guards to cross streets - don't cross mid-block! Crossing guards or student safety patrols are located at:
**Agate and Meadowlark,
Jade and Meadowlark,
and Retana and Meadowlark.**



If you drive to School...

We recommend that you park and/or drop off your children in the following areas:

- Heading south on Meadowlark, you are encouraged to drop your child off on **Agate** after turning the corner, then continue west down the hill. Please, no U-turns or blocking driveways. Children should cross with the crossing guard.
- From the neighborhood west of the school, use **Onyx** to go east (up the hill) and turn left onto **Meadowlark**. Park along the right side of **Meadowlark before Retana** to drop off children. Children should cross with the safety patrol. We are seeking volunteers to monitor from the corner at Retana to the teachers' parking lot from 8:10 am to 8:40 am.
- You may also drop off on the school side of **Meadowlark** north of the school, past the fire lane, where the No Parking signs are located.
 - Do Not Enter Authorized Parking Only signs will be posted at the teachers' parking lot. This is **not** a drop off or turn around.

Please Keep in Mind...



- Please observe all street signs and all traffic, parking and pedestrian laws.
Beware! The Madison Police Department will ticket any anyone who breaks these laws while dropping off or picking up a child.
- "No Parking" areas do allow for drop off or pick up but you cannot leave your car unattended!
 - "No Stopping, Standing, or Parking" means just that! Student pick up/drop off is NOT allowed.
 - The School Zone speed limit is 20 mph.
 - It is illegal to park within:
4 feet of a driveway,
20 feet of a crosswalk and
30 feet of a stop sign.
 - Drivers **must** yield the right of way to pedestrians crossing a street at a marked crosswalk where there is no traffic signal.
