Protective Behavior

General

- Know the three Ws concerning your child:
 1. Where your child is going.
 2. Who your child will be with.
 3. When your child will be back.

Kids at home alone

- If something about your house looks different, do not go inside.
- Lock the door when you get inside.
- Do not let anyone know you are alone:
 - If someone calls, take a message.
 - If someone knocks on the door, do not open it.
- Never go into anyone's home or car without your parents' permission.
- If you get separated from parents in a store, go to nearest checkout counter and ask for help.
- If you are in trouble, yell "HELP!"
Don't just scream.

- While on the Internet, if someone makes you feel uncomfortable, tell your parents and have them monitor the conversation you are having online.
- Never go to meet someone you met on the Internet.
- Never use sharp objects or matches.
- Use the stove only if you have permission.
- Follow the house rules.
- If you get scared or need help, be sure to have three different numbers to call or three places to go for help.
- Talk with your parents about calling 911.
